<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. AoLE Leader to identify any issues staff have with the delivery of the questions e.g. topic clashes/resources. AoLE Leader to support staff with such issues. 2. Inform all teaching staff that I will I will be looking for evidence at the end of every term. 3. Meet with PVG to discuss their 'Big Question' for current term. Children to come up with suggestions/ideas on what could be done to cover this question. 4. PVG's to speak with their class teachers to feedback what was said in their meeting. PVG to encourage class to come up with suggestions to support teachers planning of 'Big Question' 5. PVG to carry out an assembly once a term to highlight a chosen 'Big Question' from across the school. 6. AoLE to monitor coverage at the end of each term. 7. In instances where there has been no coverage, AoLE to discuss with staff member, offer support if needed and provide a deadline. 8. AoLE and PVG to take in evidence of the 'Big Questions' and monitor the standards against INSIGHT skills. 9.
