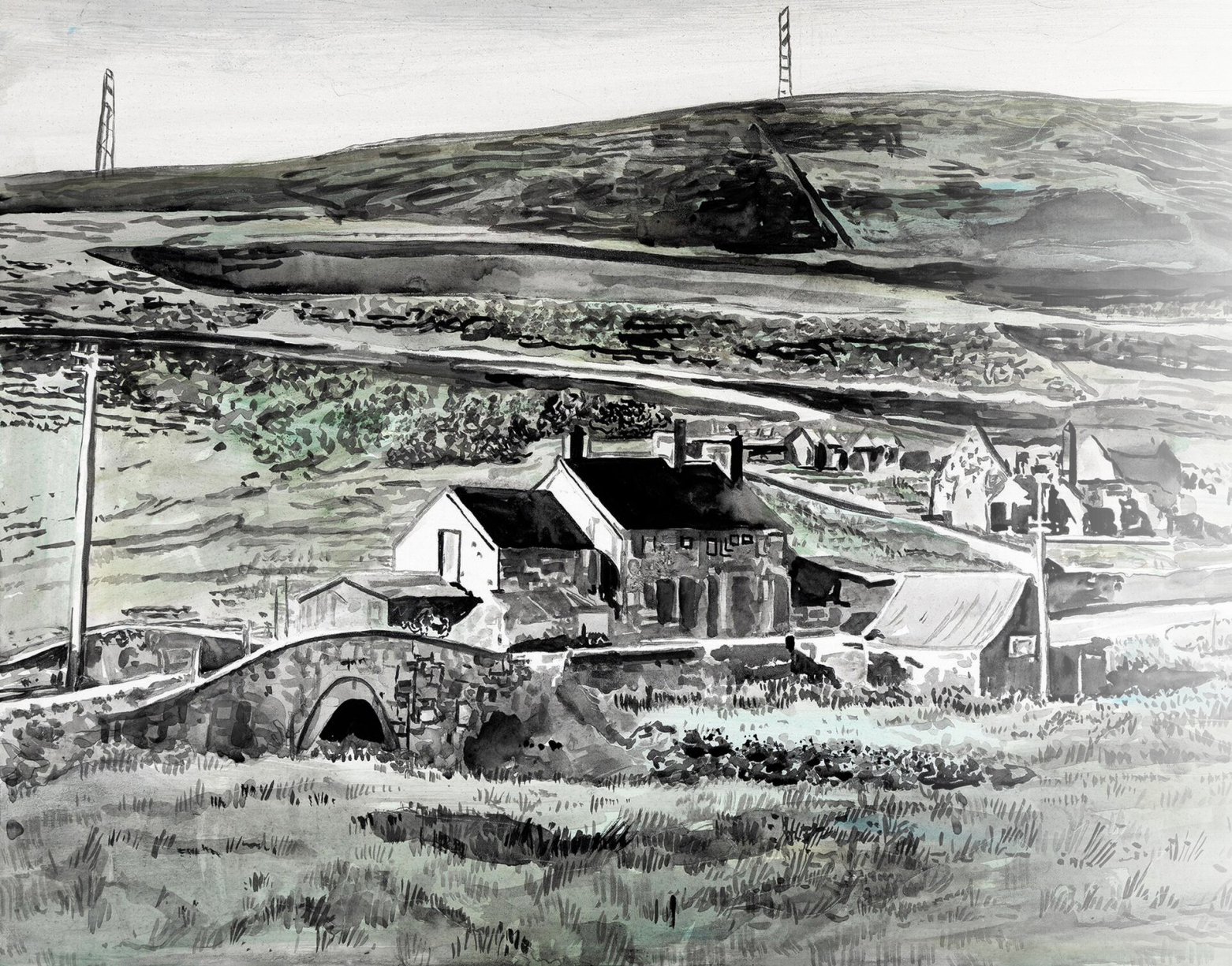
The Lost Village Of Capel Celyn
