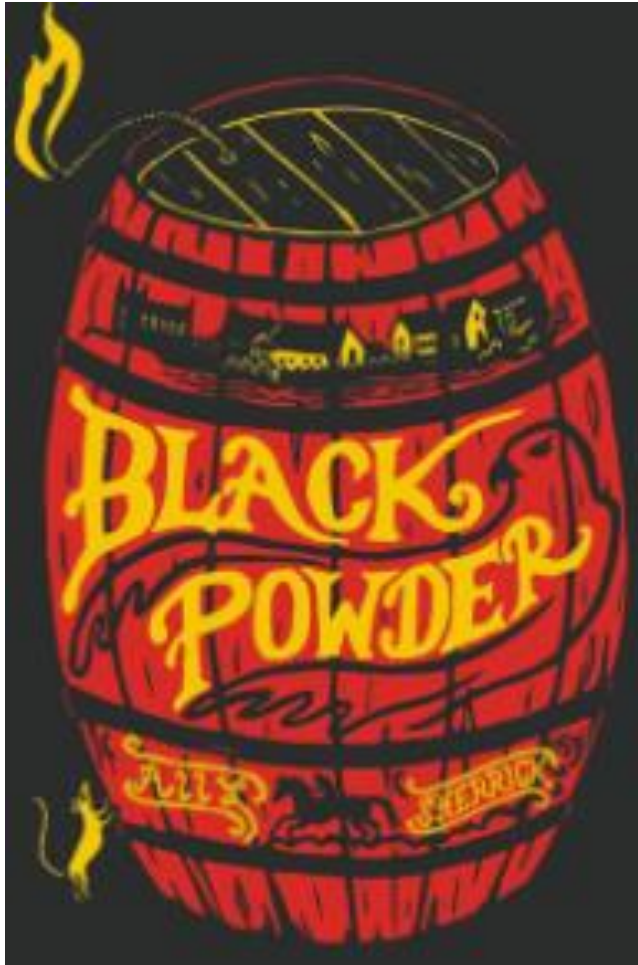


The Importance of Black Powder to Parliamentarians and Royalists
