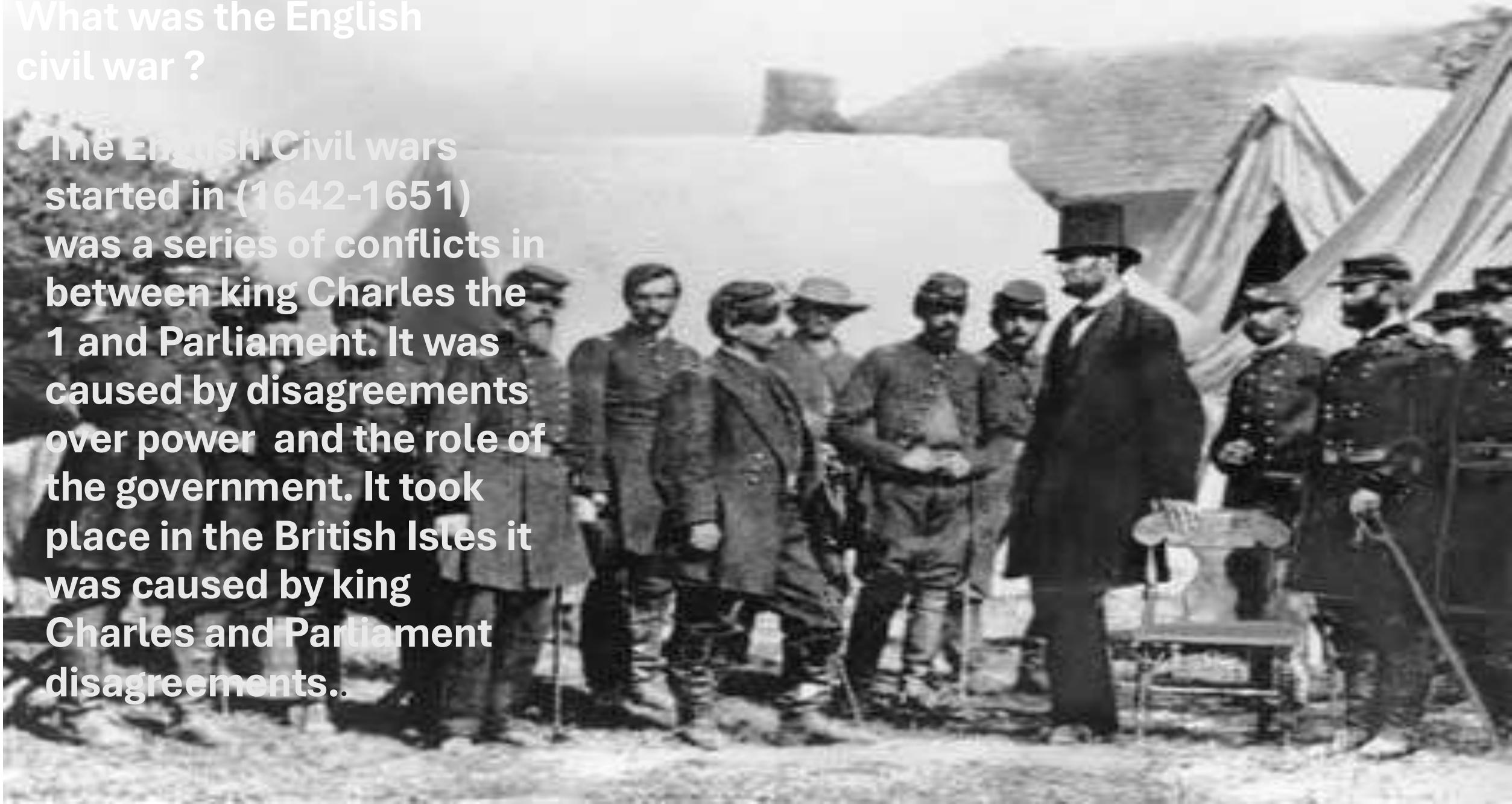
What was black Powder?
