Family

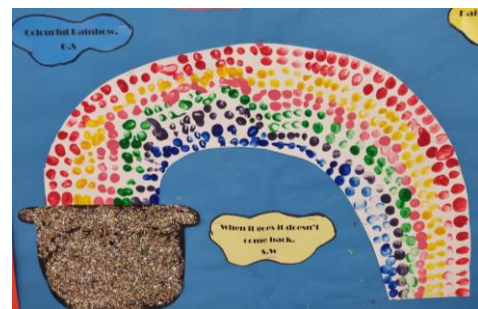
