Attendance

Please continue to help us by ensuring your child attends school and that you bring your child to school on time (before 9am). Regular school attendance is vital and missing school can have a significant impact on achievement over a one-year period as illustrated in the table below:

Attendance	Best chance of success	Your child is taking full advantage of every learning opportunity.
96 – 100% Attendance		
90 – 95% Attendance	At least 2 weeks of learning missed	Satisfactory. Your child may have to spend time catching up with work
85 – 90% Attendance	At least 4 weeks of learning missed	Your child is at risk of underachieving and may need extra support from you to catch up with work
80 – 85% Attendance	At least 5½ Weeks of learning missed	Your child's poor attendance has a significant impact on learning
Below 80% Attendance	At least 7½ weeks of learning missed	Your child is missing out on a broad and balanced education. You are at risk of prosecution.

Punctuality:

As you may be aware all schools work closely in conjunction with the Education Welfare Service in order to monitor pupil's punctuality and attendance. Our Education Welfare Officer regularly undertakes a register check in order to monitor who regularly arrives late on school premises in the mornings. Arriving late not only disrupts the routine of the class, but means that pupils also miss the all-important introduction to the first lesson of the day. Many thanks for your cooperation.

School Uniform

It's amazing when we have uniform donated that can be resold. Last summer Rachel and Kerry (Year 4 parents) raised £38 and all the money went to the PTFA. They love collecting second-hand uniform to reduce what goes to landfill. Please do donate your old uniform - but please give it a quick check over. If it is stained or ripped, then please take it to the appropriate place for recycling or refuse. Many thanks for your support as always.
